For everyone's safety, there may be some things asked of all of us that may seem intrusive, but they are for your safety and the safety of others ... which is the Christ-like thing to do!

AS YOU ARRIVE AT CHURCH

- Please remain in your vehicles until the church doors officially open for Worship -- 8:30 AM and 10:45 AM.
- There will only be three designated entrances on Sundays for Worship ... the glass double doors leading to the Sanctuary facing Main Street, under the canopy; the glass double doors at the bottom of the steps facing the rear parking lot; and the glass double doors by the Family Life Center (near the elevator).
- Please do not attempt to use any other entrance to the building – all will be locked.
- As you approach the building, please maintain and respect social distancing (of at least 6' at all times). Although it may be tempting, please do not greet others with handshakes or hugs. Not everyone will be at the same comfort level of exposure. Friendly gestures, waves, and encouraging words are welcome, from a safe distance.

ENTERING THE BUILDING

- Our plan is to utilize a nurse's station at each of the three entrances, where temperatures will be taken quickly for everyone's safety and hand sanitizer dispensed.
- Face-coverings are to be worn by all (except small children). If you do not have a mask, we should have some available.
- Please continue practicing social distancing as you enter the building.
- Please do not congregate in groups outside or inside FBC.
- Go straight into the worship areas listed below and be seated; please do not roam around the building.
- Although restrooms are available, we ask that they be limited to emergency situations. If anyone else is in the restroom, please wait until they exit.

WORSHIP AREAS (SANCTUARY, FAMILY LIFE CENTER, OR FELLOWSHIP HALL)

- As you enter the Sanctuary, Family Life Center, or Fellowship Hall, you will be directed to your seats. Thank you in advance for lending your full cooperation and understanding with this new seating process.
- There will not be any handouts at this time (bulletin, etc.) to minimize person-to-person contact. On Communion Sundays, you will have the opportunity to safely obtain self-serve and self-contained communion cups/wafers as you arrive.
- Social distancing will be designated and observed (every other pew restricted; and family units spaced 6' apart)

LEAVING THE SERVICE

- We will dismiss by rows.
- You will have an opportunity to place tithes and offerings in each worship location as you exit the service.
- As you depart and safely return to your vehicle, please continue to observe social distancing at all times.

Sorry, no coffee, refreshments, meals, or social gatherings in this initial phase of our ReStart. At this time, we are simply opening our doors for Sunday Morning Worship Services.

All family units are expected to stay together during your entire worship experience.

Preschool, Children's and Youth programming has not resumed just yet.
